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These books are from the library of the order of the Kapuziners (Capuchin friars) dating back to the early 18th century. The conservation experts of the Steiermärkische Landesbibliothek preserve them and make them available to be enjoyed in the long term.

MISSION OF THE STEIERMÄRKISCHE LANDESBIBLIOTHEK

The most important function of a library is to proficiently provide information. The Steiermärkische Landesbibliothek, with more than 800,000 media pieces, provides basic literature from all disciplines. It acts as an interface between university libraries and your local city library.

Its speciality, the Styriaca collection and the resulting Styrian bibliography, a comprehensive documentation on Styria (Steiermark), its products, its inhabitants, is considered an inexhaustible pool of topics. But the State Library is also an ideal point of contact for work from the humanities.

Our offering during opening times (Monday and Friday 09.00–17.00 h, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 09.00–18.00 h) are

- the rental area incl. user PCs (free Wi-Fi),
- the open access library,
- the microfilm reading area,
- the reading and magazine reading room (free Wi-Fi),
- and the children's and youth library,

all free of charge.

In addition, you can visit presentations and exhibitions in the State Library at no cost to you.

The library card costs 5 euros for students of our schools and universities (instead of 7 euros) per year. The usual rental period is four weeks.

A valid picture ID card is required to get a library card issued.

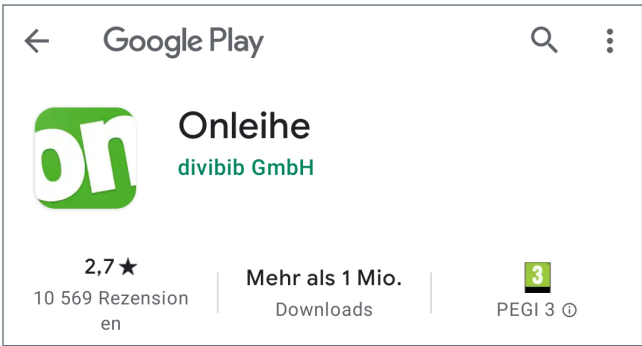
The State Library opening times during summer and Christmas vacations are 09.00–13.00 h.

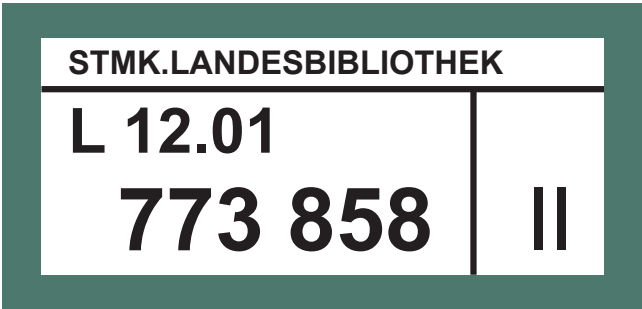

Library usage

Research PCs, our academic staff, and our open access library are available to help you find and check out your desired medium. About 30,000 works are available in the open access area, but most of the more than 800,000 media copies are in the library's storage. Usually, you can find all desired media on our website in the 'Online catalogue' or just check with our expert staff.

eBooks

The library offers more than 30,000 eMedia works. The corresponding online borrowing OnleiheAPP is available on the homepage of the website in DigiBib. You can activate its functionalities by entering your User Name and date of birth.

Novels and non-fiction books like online travel guides, for example, can be checked out for three weeks at a time.

The format is compatible with all eReaders, PCs, tablets and smartphones. The eBook reader 'Kindle' will not work, because of the Amazon software.

Accession number

Each book has a label with its specific accession number. The label is usually white; green for the Styrian media.

Accession number, book title and author are the most important pieces of information for finding the correct book or desired media.

Structure of the accession number label:

>> Arabic digits (consecutive book numbers) and

>> Roman numerals (book sizes ranging from I=small to IV= very large);

>> sometimes including letters:

- P for periodicals
- D for the reading room (these media cannot be check out outside the library) or
- L for the open access stacks

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READ AND LEARN IN PEACE

The Steiermärkische Landesbibliothek is considered an insider tip for readers and learners. This is where you will find several quiet, bright and transparently designed climate-controlled rooms where you can learn and work at your leisure. The following library rooms are available to you:

Open access library

The open access library area offers about 30,000 pieces for you to search and access on your own.

This is where you will find any particular new publications, sorted by subject area.

Our local library staff are available to answer questions and will be happy to help you with checking out your media.

During renovations the reading room was equipped with new furniture as well as new infrastructure and now is bright, climate-controlled, spacious and has free Wi-Fi access. To round out the offer, we have made lockable 'dissertation boxes' available for three months without charge to the students.

The magazine reading room with various magazines from a number of fields as well as Styrian, Austrian and some foreign newspapers are also available free of charge.

Unfortunately, the media cannot be borrowed and taken outside of these two rooms. But copies can be made in the checkout area.

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CHILDREN'S AND YOUTH LIBRARY

The children's and youth libraries are located close to the entrance of the Steiermärkische Landesbibliothek. The open access rooms are usually occupied with highly sought-after programmes, enjoyed by schools, daycares, and after-school centres. The programmes consist of events ranging from presentations to workshops, picture book cinema to the most diverse forms of children's and youth theatre performances throughout the year. One particular annual portfolio focuses, for example, on topics such as "being different", "being together – for each other – against each other" or "Our Homeland". There are several schools around the State Library within walking distance. The teachers and the staff of these institutions in particular like to take advantage of the State Library's offers, because like all events of the library they are free to attend.

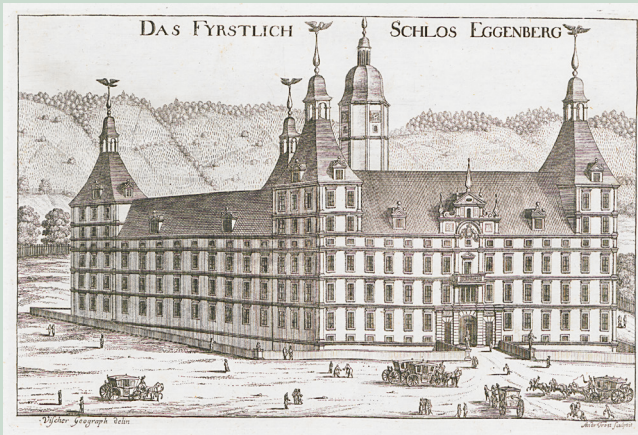

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WHAT ELSE IS THERE IN THE STATE LIBRARY?

Bookbinding

The professional bookbinding team rids old, valuable books from mould and fungi, cleans and improves pages, restores old leather covers, and produces hand-made protective covers for the storage of particularly valuable books. Bequests of legacy documents, like those of the Kapuziner order (Capuchin friars) or by Peter Rosegger, are restored with this valuable craftsmanship and now available for viewing by our patrons.

Exhibition and events hall

The Steiermärkische Landesbibliothek offers a wide range of event programmes to open the venue to our patrons, to increase publicity, and to fulfil the educational mission in a contemporary way. Exhibitions taking place in the beautiful baroque event hall are a way to present the diverse collections of the house in a thematic way. Since 2013, all exhibitions have been exclusively related to the book, but there are also very artistic approaches to the object.
